Provincial Achievement Test Results Report for 2018-2019 November 1, 2019

## WHERE THE WORLD OPENS UP

#### OUR STUDENTS POSSESS THE CONFIDENCE, RESILIENCE, INSIGHT AND SKILLS REQUIRED TO THRIVE IN, AND POSITIVELY IMPACT, THE WORLD.

This report summarizes the results achieved by Greystone Centennial Middle School's grade six and grade nine students for the June 2019 Provincial Achievement Test period.

#### Assessment for Learning

School administration and staff carefully analyze the results of the June 2019 Provincial Achievement Tests to guide classroom instruction moving forward.

With respect to Provincial Achievement Tests:

The School surpassed the Province of Alberta's results on:

- 5 of 8 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Acceptable Standard; and
- 2 of 8 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Standard of Excellence.

The School surpassed Parkland School Division's results on:

- 5 of 8 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Acceptable Standard; and
- 6 of 8 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Standard of Excellence.

The School results surpassed last year's results on:

- 3 of 8 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Acceptable Standard, and
- 5 of 8 Provincial Achievement Tests at the Standard of Excellence.

The Chart on the next page provides detailed areas of growth and results for our school in comparison to the provincial and school division results.

- GCMS' results at the Standard of Excellence surpassed the Province and the Parkland School Division's results in 6 and 5 PAT tests respectively. Additionally, we have also seen growth in these areas from previous years.
- Our Science 6 results are 7.2% higher than the Province at the Acceptable Standard, and 4.9% higher than PSD. They also show growth of 1.5% from the previous year. Social 6 also shows growth from the previous year of 5.2% and 6.6% higher than the Province at the Acceptable Standard.
- Our results on the Reading Portion of the Grade 6 ELA PAT are quite strong. 90.9% of the students who wrote the exam achieved the Acceptable Standard and 41.4% of students writing achieved the Standard of Excellence.
- We would like to see improvement in our Grade 9 ELA and Math PAT at both the Acceptable Standard and the Standard of Excellence. These are areas of continued focus.
